Drop-off & Pick-up/Use of Playground

Just a reminder to please practice physical distancing amongst families when waiting outside to drop off or pick up your child.

Also, a reminder to collect your child(ren) and leave the school site as soon as possible at the end of the day. We are working very hard to limit the amount of contact between Learning Groups during the school day we would appreciate your cooperation in doing so once the bells have gone.

Medical Alerts

We are continuing to update our medical alert information at the office. If you are a new parent with a child who has a medical alert or a returning family with a child who has recently developed a medical condition, please contact the school office so as we can update our information and ensure we have all the necessary paperwork. Medical alerts are typically those with a life-threatening diagnosis such as an anaphylaxis allergy or asthma. Any other medical concerns can be shared with the classroom teacher and you will then be directed to the office to complete paperwork if necessary.

Student Absences

If your child is going to be late or away for any reason, please call the school office before 9:00 a.m. to confirm their absence. You can also leave a message on the answering machine with the following information:

- 1. Child's first and last name (please spell last name)
- 2. Teacher and Division
- 3. Absent or late (please give anticipated arrival time)

If we do not hear from you, we will call home to ensure your child's safety.
