IMPORTANT NOTE: PACs need a Treasurer to apply for the government's Community Gaming Grant. If this position can't be filled, we will not be able to submit our application for the grant, nor offer activities such as hot lunch and fundraisers.

The following roles are open for 2022/2023:

Treasurer (1-2 volunteers could share the duties)

Time commitment: 3-4 hours a month (requires some banking duties at our branch near the school)

- Responsible for PAC payments, reimbursements, and deposits.
- Maintains financial records (eg. spreadsheet of PAC expenses/funds).
- Provides term-end / year-end reports.
- Assists in revising the budget for the following school year (presented at May PAC meeting)
- Re-applies for PAC Gaming Grant and submits follow-up documentation by deadline.

Note: District PAC has a training webinar for prospective treasurers (with no experience) on March 29, 7pm-8:30pm on Zoom.

Secretary

Time commitment: 1-2 hours a month

- Responsible for taking minutes at PAC meetings (we have 6 a year) on Tuesday evenings.
- Forwarding draft minutes for final check before they're shared at next meeting and posted to Confed website
- Help coordinate PAC events or activities, if possible.
