Principal's Report: Helena Readman

- Family Literacy Day featured storytelling and games of bingo as well as a recorded Community Gathering. Parents provided with a Vimeo link.
- Boomerang is the only club currently running. Students supporting Diabetes Canada & Spirit Days
- Ms Safarik is currently working with students on creating artwork for the ceiling tiles.
- Some health and safety rules have lifted:
 - o Regular lunch will occur after Spring Break.
 - o Will most likely start to meet more in person.
 - o Students will have access to the entire playground and surroundings of buildings.
 - o Track and Field
- Art in the Park: Gather mural ideas which the District approved.
