
Our school-wide goal continues in Math this year. The goal reads as follows; 'Students will experience increased joy in and perseverance when participating in mathematical activities, explore with intrigue and interest, and consider themselves a mathematician in a positive light.'

In order to work on this goal, we have participated in regular check-in conversations on staff including sharing ideas through our Math Committee. Ideas have included setting weekly math questions for reflection and conversation, math questions over the morning announcements and playing math games during the week based on math facts. Students have enjoyed participating in these activities and even creating their own explorations for others to try out. See below a few examples of these from students in Division 1.









Math Explorations – Division 1

Another school-wide initiative we are exploring this term is a painted mural which will be installed at the front of the school to the right of the Pandora Street entrance. We have organized nine large panels to be delivered to the school (one for each division) and we are soon going to begin a large mural based on the work of Jackson Pollock. The painting of this mural will involve every child in the school and will be a thoughtful process of layering paint over paint, using colour schemes that compliment each other and using various body movements and techniques to apply the colours in turn. We look forward to seeing this come together over the next few months and hope it will be installed by the end of the school year. Looking forward to sharing this with you later this term.

WHY THIS IS URGENT

PACs need a Treasurer to qualify for the government's Community Gaming Grant, and provide financial transparency and accountability.

If we do not have a volunteer for Treasurer for 2022/2023, we will not be allowed to accept the government grant of approximately \$4000, nor can we run hot lunch.

The members of the exec committee do the bulk of our communicating and organizing online when possible because everyone has full-time commitments elsewhere. No experience necessary — just the desire to help behind the scenes.

The following roles are open for 2022/2023:

<u>Treasurer (1-2 volunteers could share the duties)</u>

Time commitment: 3-4 hours a month (requires some banking duties at our branch near the school to deposit cheques)

- -Responsible for PAC payments, reimbursements, and deposits (usually related to hot lunch, fundraisers, and fund disbursement)
- -Maintains financial records (eg. spreadsheet of PAC expenses/funds).
- -Provides term-end / year-end reports.
- -Assists in revising the budget for the following school year (presented at May PAC meeting)
- -Re-applies for PAC Gaming Grant and submits follow-up documentation by deadline.
- -Provides financial update at PAC meetings

Secretary (1-2 volunteers could share the duties)

Time commitment: 1-2 hours a month

- -Responsible for taking minutes at PAC meetings (we have 6 a year) on Tuesday evenings.
- -Forwarding draft minutes for final check before they're shared at next meeting and posted publicly to Confed website
- -Help coordinate PAC events or activities, if possible.
