

Much of the planning and organizing is flexible and not limited to 9-5. When we do need helpers during the school day, we make sure the request clearly states the time-frame.

Confed Park PAC Committee Members 2022/2023




Joanne has volunteered with the school's hot lunch program, art show, and has been a class parent-rep in recent years. She will be one of the Hot Lunch Coordinators this year.


