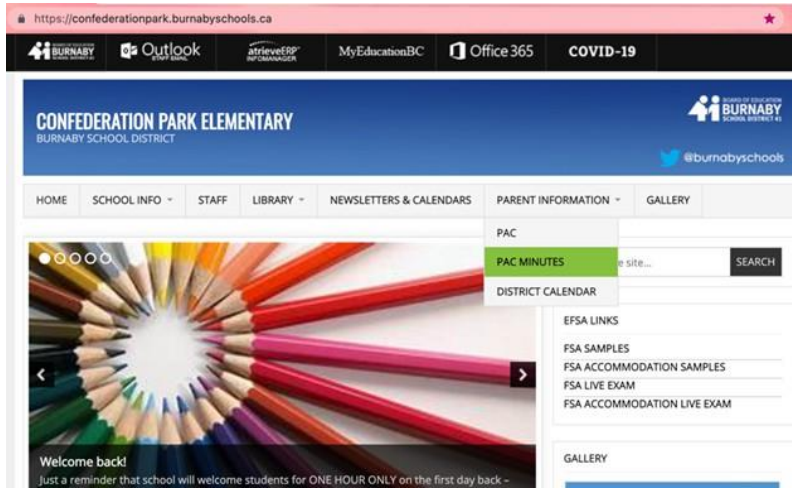
We plan to hold meetings on the third Wednesday of each month in the evenings in person and online via Zoom. Watch for announcements to
