1. Absent/Sick/Late Students

The office needs to hear from the parent/guardian by **9:15am** if a student is going to be absent, sick, or late (even if you have already told the teacher).

Please provide the following information:

- Student's first & last name
 - Dates and times
 - Division or Teacher's Name
 - Reason your child is absent (i.e. sick, vacation, appointment, arriving late, leaving early, etc.).
- Please note, students arriving late must enter the school through their classroom door, and then **sign-in** at the office. Students leaving early must be **signed-out** at the office by the parent/guardian.
 - If your child will be absent for an extended period (i.e. vacation), please complete an [Extended Absence Form](#).

3. West Coast Recess

Students go outside at recess and lunch regardless of the weather, rain or shine. Please ensure your child comes to school dressed appropriately for the weather. It is also recommended to leave a change of clothes at school in case students fall or get wet.

4. Digital Consent Forms – to be completed in September

5. English Language Assessments

As part of the District's commitment to supporting multilingual learners, students new to the Burnaby School District may qualify for additional services to support their English language development. To determine eligibility, when students first start school, our ELL teachers conduct a short English language assessment for those who are new to Canada, speak a language other than English at home, or have not attended an English speaking school before. This is a standard part of our process to determine whether students would benefit from additional English language support as part of their learning program. If the assessment indicates that your child qualifies for English Language Learning (ELL) support, the ELL teacher will send home a note with your child's ELL level and information about the ELL program.
